

Let's discuss...Grooming

INTRODUCING THE TOPIC	Grooming is when someone builds an emotional connection with a young person to gain their trust for the purposes of sexual abuse, sexual exploitation or trafficking. Young people can be groomed online or face-to-face, by a stranger or by someone they know Groomers can be male or female and any age.
THINGS TO KNOW AND TALK ABOUT	 Targeting the victim (could be through social media, or on a gaming site, or in the real world) Gaining the trust of the victim (typically the groomer tries to identify with the victim, to show understanding, compassion, or shared experience) Filling a need of the victim (could be in the form of friendship, understanding, flattery, or by offering some sort of expertise) Isolating the victim (the groomer claims they are the only person who understands, and discourages the victim from socializing with usual friends or family) Sexualising the relationship (once the relationship is established, a sexual element is introduced) Maintaining control (through continued flattery, or bribery, or threats) The process may take many months, or even years, but can also be really quick, depending on the skill of the groomer and the vulnerability of the potential victim.
