Submit your results and ID Photo

Examination results should be available from your school/college on Thursday 24 August.

We will send you an email which contains a link for you to submit your GCSE results and ID Photo. **It is essential that we hold a correct email address for you.**

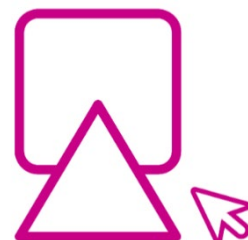
The email address we plan to use is included in your enrolment letter containing your appointment details.

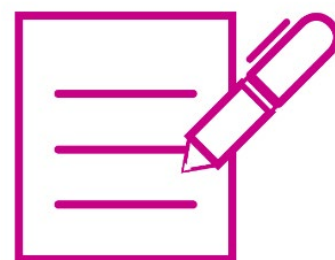
STEP 3
