

# **Unplanned Absences**

#### **Short Term Illness**

Student must email <a href="mailto:absence@wqe.ac.uk">absence@wqe.ac.uk</a> by 10.00 am each day they are absent, giving:

- PPM name
- Student number
- Brief details of illness

Any emails sent after 10.00am will be recorded as unauthorised.

# Signing Out Sick

See your own PPM or another PPM at either site, in person.

## **Medical Reasons**

PPM refers to W&S so that medical information can be recorded and suitable support and arrangements for keeping up with studies can be put in place.

# **Short Term Planned Absences**

For one or two days <u>or</u> for Elite Sport/ Work Experience/ Educational Visit

PPM makes decision on approval. Email PPM well in advance:

- Giving reason
- Evidence
- Dates/times/lessons missed

# **Planned Absences**

### For three or more days

Request by letter/email from Parent/Carer to the Principal

### **Routine Requests**

For a request to be considered for approval it will usually meet these criteria:

- Have a very good reason for having to occur during term time
- Be made at least 3 weeks in advance of the dates requested
- Current attendance well above 90%
- Not clash with any:
  - External exams
  - Coursework deadlines
  - Controlled assessment windows
  - o Internal College assessments
- Be for no more than five College days (this allows for a two-week visit when combined with a halfterm break, or a three week visit when combined with the Christmas or Easter break)

## **Emergency Requests**

For a request to be considered for approval it normally must meet these criteria:

- Be of an unforeseen/emergency nature
- Be made with as much notice as possible
- Not clash with any external exams
- Be for no more than five College days (this allows for a two-week visit when combined with a halfterm break or a three week visit when combined with the Christmas or Easter break)

# What will happen if I decide to go ahead with an unapproved planned absence?

- The absence will be recorded as unauthorised.
- Daily absence communications from the College will continue.
- The attendance percentage will go down; attendance levels are often included in references from the College.
- As the College has no legal powers over attendance, students or parents/carers will not be fined. If an exam is missed the College reserves the right to reclaim the costs from you.
- Students must take responsibility for keeping up with their studies without placing additional burden on teaching staff. They should access the resources made available for your class via WQEOnline/MS Teams.
- If more than four college weeks in a row are missed, the student will be withdrawn from college.
