

STEP 1

Submit your GCSE results

Examination results should be available from your school/college on Thursday 21 August.

Email your GCSE results to enrolsession1@wqe.ac.uk.

We will send you a reminder link – for this reason **it is essential that we hold a correct email address for you**. The email address we plan to use is included in your enrolment letter. **If you no longer have access to this email address, please contact admissions@wqe.ac.uk by Friday 9 August to provide an alternative.**



STEP 2

Complete your course enrolment: Wednesday 27 August

- Your course enrolment will take place at LCPA
- You will meet with Tim Rogers, Associate Principal, to confirm your study programme. This will include GCSE English Language and/or Mathematics if you have not achieved grade 4 or above in these essential subjects.



STEP 3

Attend Orientation: Monday 1 September at 11:00 WQE University Road Campus

Please arrive by 11:00am and go to the Sports Hall to have your photo taken for your WQE ID Card. You will then be directed to the Orientation Welcome Talk.
