ACCOUNTABLE TO: Head of Studies

JOB PURPOSE To support the Heads of Studies in provide efficient, responsive and flexible leadership of the arrangements for monitoring and supporting students' progress in order to ensure the provision of the best possible learning experiences and outcomes for students, as well as to fostering a culture of continuous improvement

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

- To work positively and collaboratively within the leadership and management structure of the College
- To support the Head of Studies in making decisions about individual student programmes of study
- To support the Head of Studies in overseeing arrangements for monitoring, supporting and communicating students' general attendance, performance and progress - both individual and group elements
- To provide support to the Heads of Studies in managing staff in the Guidance Team, including sharing performance management and reviewing, organising and monitoring the day-to-day operation of the team.
- To support the Heads of Studies in the implementation of the disciplinary processes for students and manage individual students at the intermediate stages of the disciplinary process
- To be a key point of contact for issues of student management during the College day, responding to staff, students or external stakeholders as required to manage the good order of the College, having access to all the relevant information (including confidential information) about students to inform this management.
- To support the Head of Studies in the preparation of PPM group session materials and resources including planning, creation, and day to day organisation. This includes supporting Heads of Studies in the Quality Assurance of PPM 1-2-1 and group sessions.
- To oversee the tracking and monitoring and completion of online study modules. Implementation appropriate action where modules are not being completed in stipulated timeframes.
- To support the system and arrangements for the completion of student references.

- To support the Head of Studies in monitoring the impact of the arrangements for supporting student progress, including the monitoring of key data and indicators, self- assessment and improvement planning
- To support the Heads of Studies in working with the Careers Education Manager, to manage the arrangements for advice and guidance in relation to preparation for further study and for the world of work, to include careers education guidance, work experience and work readiness/employability

GENERAL RESPONSIBILITIES

- To ensure the adherence to the College’s policies and procedures with regard to the safeguarding of, and promotion of, the welfare of students
- To ensure the application of the College’s Single Equality Scheme including valuing diversity and promoting equality
- To implement the College’s Health & Safety policy and procedures within the post holders own area of responsibility
- To support, promote and operate in line with the College mission and values
- Commitment to the continuous improvement of services offered by the College
- Any other reasonable duties commensurate with the role as required
